



## Emma Webster Calvert

Emma Webster Calvert, of Easton, died at The Talbot Hospice House, Easton, on Tuesday, May 22, 2001. She was 83.

Born in Hebron, MD, March 4, 1918, she was the daughter of the late Gleamon and Della Ford Webster. After graduating from Hebron High School, she began work as a beautician. She eventually owned and operated her own shop, Beauty Crafts, in Salisbury until its close in the mid-60's.

A resident of Easton since 1962, she was a member of St. Mark's United Methodist Church in Easton and the Sarah Circle of the United Methodist Women of the church. Other memberships included the Talbot Country Club and the Ladies of the Elks, Easton Lodge #1622 of which she served as President for three terms. Her hobbies included playing golf and bridge.

Mrs. Calvert is survived by her husband, Gordon K. Calvert whom she married in Salisbury on January 15, 1949; a son, Dr. Gordon K. Calvert, Jr. and his wife, Barbara, of Oxford and three grandchildren, Cristina, Jessica and Drew Calvert. Her sister, Janet Taylor, and two brothers, Wilson Webster and William Webster are deceased.

Funeral services will be held on Thursday, May 24, 2001 at 2 PM at St. Mark's United Methodist Church, Easton.

Burial will be at the Oxford Cemetery, Oxford, MD.
