Col. Emory V. Hogans, Jr. died as the result of a fall on August 7, 2002 in Jacksonville, Florida at the age of 82 years.

He was the son of the late Emory V., Sr. and Helen A. Hogans of Rock Hall. He attended school in Rock Hall and was called to active Army service in January 1942. He had himself transferred to the U.S. Air Force where he became a Bomber Pilot and Flight Instructor.

At the end of WWII he returned to Rock Hall, MD and served as Captain of the Chestertown Army National Guard during the early 1950's. He was later assigned to the 5th Regiment Armory Headquarters in Baltimore and retired from service in 1984.

His first wife, Elizabeth M. Lewis died in 1984. He later remarried and is survived by his wife, Nellie in Florida; a brother, Franklin T. Hogans, Sr. of Rock Hall, MD; a sister, Laura Hogans Boyer of Chestertown, MD and dear friends, Roger and Ann Sassamon.

Funeral services will be held on Tuesday, August 13, 2002 at 11:30 AM in Wesley Chapel United Methodist Church in Rock Hall, MD where relatives and friends may call one hour prior to service. Interment will be in Wesley Chapel Cemetery.
