Enid Hughes Stackus of Easton, MD, died on Sunday, July 31, 2016, at her home. She was 94.

Enid was born on March 25, 1922, in London, England, to the late John H. Hughes and Jean Pritchard Hughes. She and her family moved from England to Minnesota when she was very young. While in school, they moved to Idlewild, MD, where she graduated from Towson High School, Class of 1939. On May 24, 1942, she married Walter L. Stackus in Rockville, MD, after meeting him at the Boca Raton Club in Florida years prior, and they made their home in Lutherville, MD.
