: Enid Erma Usilton, loving wife and mother, died on Thursday, March 25, 2004 after a long battle with Alzheimer's. She was 81.

Born January 7, 1923, she was raised in Baltimore where she worked many years for the State of Maryland Correctional Institution as a dietician, retiring in 1982. At the time of her retirement she was awarded the Certificate of Awards for faithful service to the people of Maryland from two Governors. On April 30, 1974 she was awarded in appreciation of five years of faithful service from Governor Marvin Mandel and she received the same award for ten years of faithful service from Governor Harry Hughes. She also received an award from the Department of Education.

She was a member of the Price Bethany United Methodist Church and the Price Community Club.

Mrs. Usilton is survived by her husband, Milford Usilton of Centreville; three children, Janet La Foille of Pennsylvania, William Meeker of Maryland and Anthony Meeker, Sr. of Maryland; a step-son, David L. Usilton of Centreville, MD; seven grandchildren, Enid Susan, Cheryl Stoltzfus, Elinore Taylor, Brian William, David W. Usilton, Mary Usilton and Logan Lewis; 9 great grandchildren and 12 great great grandchildren.
