February 21, 1926 - June 17, 2011

E. Pearle Starkey of Queenstown, MD died on Friday, June 17, 2011 at Corsica Hills Nursing Home. She was 85 years old.

Mrs. Starkey was born on February 21, 1926 in Centreville, MD to the late Robert D. Dill, Sr. and Estella R. Russum Dill. She attended school in Centreville until coming home to care for her mother. On September 5, 1942, she married William H. Starkey and they resided in Centreville. In 1947, they made their home in Queenstown.

Mrs. Starkey worked for Murdoch's Florist in Centreville in the mid 1950's and later with Avlo's Restaurant as a waitress in the 1960's. Most of her life was spent at home caring for her family, raising her children, and assisting her husband on the farm.

Mrs. Starkey is a member of the Calvary United Methodist Church in Queenstown and the Queenstown Homemakers.

Mrs. Starkey is survived by her loving husband of 68 years, William; two children, Virginia S. Lewis and her husband, Charles, and Robert W. Starkey; two grandchildren, Brenda S. Williams and her husband, James "Hank", and Charles C. Lewis, III and his wife, Alisa; two great grandchildren, Aaron Christopher Lewis and Caden Joseph Lewis; and one sister, Gladys Whitby.
