



## Ernest T. Brown

November 20, 1926 - March 24, 2017

Ernest Theodore Brown of Chester, MD, formerly of Pasadena, MD, died Friday March 24, 2017, at Anne Arundel Medical Center in Annapolis, MD. He was 90.

Born on November 20, 1926, in Irwin, PA, the son of the late Charles E. Brown and Mary Bergins. Ernie grew up in Irwin, PA, and was a graduate of Norwin High School. After graduating, he enlisted in the Navy serving during WW II. When he was honorably discharged from the Navy, he returned to Irwin, PA, and attended Carnegie Tech in Pittsburgh. He would then meet the love of his life Ruth Coles and marry her on November 20, 1951.

They resided in Irwin, PA, as Ernie began his career in mechanical engineering with Newel and Son as a foreman machinist and later with Westinghouse. Employed with Westinghouse brought them to Pasadena, MD, where Ernie would retire after 27 years. They would continue to reside in Pasadena where he was a member of the Mt. Carmel United Methodist Church and will always be remembered for helping out neighbors and friends as he loved to tinker with anything. His favorite pastimes were playing cards, hunting, and fishing, especially the trips to the hunting camp. Due to declining health, they moved to Annapolis and just recently to Chester, MD, to be closer to family.

He is survived by his wife of 65 years, Ruth L. Brown (nee Coles); son, Robert C. Brown (Mary) of Finksburg, MD; daughter, Laurie B. Westling (Ed) of Chester, MD; sister, Janet Fink (Jim) of Redlands, CA; and grandchildren, Jenna Brown and Alexander Brown.
