Ernest T. Heinefield of Rock Hall, Maryland died on February 27, 2006 in Chester River Hospital Center, Chestertown, Maryland. He was 68.

Born on January 14, 1938 in Rock Hall, he was the son of the late Herman John and Catherine Reihl Heinefield. He was educated in Rock Hall and went to work as a carpenter at a very young age, working with his family. He worked as a carpenter his entire life, until his illness. Mr. Heinefield served in the U.S. Army and completed his services with the Army National Guard and was honorably discharged in May of 1961. He was a member of the Sgt. Preston Ashley American Legion, Post #228 in Rock Hall. He enjoyed making bird houses, picture frames, and anything having to do with carpentry. He also loved country music.

Mr. Heinefield is survived by one sister, Mildred Rafine of Rock Hall, two brothers: Jerry Martin Heinefield and Herman Junior Heinefield, both of Rock Hall, four nephews: John Rafine, Frederick Heinefield, Jerry Lee Heinefield, and Martin Heinefield, and two nieces: Catherine Herbert and Mary Ann Parker.
