Ernest A. Kendall, Jr. of Chestertown, MD, died on Wednesday, July 6, 2011, at Chester River Hospital Center. He was 64 years old.

Mr. Kendall was born on May 22, 1947, in Chestertown, MD. He was the son of the late Ernest A. Kendall, Sr. and Ethel Elizabeth Watson Kendall. He attended Rock Hall High School and graduated in 1965. Mr. Kendall served for three years in the United States Marine Corps during the Vietnam War as a Machine Gunner with the 3rd Marine Division.

He was married to his first wife, Shirley Cahall Kendall, for ten years then later married Sandra Patchett Kendall for seven years. Mr. Kendall worked as a heavy equipment operator for 33 years with Union 77 and with Arnold Perko and Sons Construction until he retired in 2005.
