



Ernest H. Murray Jr.

May 16, 1928 - March 24, 2018

Ernest Hastings Murray Jr., 89, passed away Saturday, March 24, 2018, at Bayleigh Chase in Easton, MD.

Ernest "Ernie" was born in Salisbury, MD, on May 16, 1928, to the late Ernest Hastings Murray, Sr. and Helen Layfield Murray. He graduated from Wicomico High School in 1945. Ernie met his wife, Jeannine "Jen" Irene Mitchell, while they were both working for the F.B.I. in Washington, DC, and they married in 1950.

While working at the FBI, Ernie received a personal commendation letter from Director Hoover recognizing his "unstinting commitment to duty." Ernie attended college at Benjamin Franklin University (since merged into George Washington University), and earned an MBA. He later became a C.P.A. Along with Jim Cavanaugh, they formed Murray and Cavanaugh PC, CPA's in Rosslyn, VA.

In 1986, Ernie and Jen retired to Martingham and enjoyed golfing, traveling and entertaining. Ernie also volunteered his services as a CPA through AARP. Ernie and Jen moved to The Easton Club where Ernie was active in the community. They spent summers with family and friends at their cottage on Lake Opinicon in Ontario, Canada.

Ernie is survived by his wife, sons John and Tom, their spouses Chris and Paul, grandchildren Jason and Alison, Jason's wife Tiffany, and grandchild, Henry.

Funeral services will be private.
