Ernest David “DA” Young of Centreville, MD died at the Memorial Hospital, Easton, MD on Monday, August 28, 2006. He was 70.

Born July 30, 1936 in Haverhill, MA, he was the son of the late Edward J. and Melina J. Paris Young. He attended Haverhill, MA schools.
