Ernest E. "Ernie" Fisher, III of Easton, MD died on Thursday, March 13, 2003 at Memorial Hospital at Easton. He was 48.

Born May 8, 1954 in Easton, MD, he was the son of Ernest E. and Anita L. Schuyler Fisher, Jr. He graduated from Easton High School in 1972 and then served in the United States Marine Corp. After his release from active duty, he drove long distance tractor-trailers for Koski Trucking and worked for the Christmas Attic. In 1990 he took a position with the MD State Highway Administration where he remained until the time of his death.

A member of St. Mark's United Methodist Church, Easton, he was also a life member of the Marine Corp League and the Military Order of Devil Dogs, where he was in charge of Toys for Tots. He was also a member of American Legion Post #70, past King Lion of the Easton Lions Club, and a past member of Cabinet 22B of Lions Club International.

In addition to his parents, Mr. Fisher is survived by a brother, Robert G. "Chumley" Fisher of Easton; a sister, Brenda Fisher Ramage and her husband, Tom of Easton; a niece, Michele A. Patrick of Easton; two nephews, Thomas Ramage and Dylan Ramage, both of Easton and several aunts and uncles.

Funeral services will be held on Tuesday, March 18, 2003 at 11:00 AM at Fellows, Helfenbein & Newnam Funeral Home, P.A., Easton. Friends may call on Monday evening from 6 to 8 PM.

Burial will be at Maryland Eastern Shore Veterans Cemetery, Hurlock, MD.
