



## Ernest Leon Massey

Ernest Leon Massey of Church Hill died on Monday, December 24, 2001 at his home. He was 83.

Born on August 25, 1918, he was the son of the late Charles T. and Sallie Massey. On November 24, 1924 he married Lula Mae Morris of Hayden, Maryland. In addition to being a loving father and grandfather, he farmed in Ruthsburg until 1959, when he moved to Church Hill. There he was a member of the C.H.V.F.D. He worked for Church Hill Lumber Co. and Cape Pine Farm, and began to own and train standard bred race horses, as well as being a school bus contractor with the Queen Anne's County Board of education. He was later employed at Roland's Auto, retiring in 1998.

Mr. Massey is survived by a son, Morris "Butch" Massey of Worton; a daughter, Sally Coursey and her husband Butch of Church Hill; six grandchildren, Wendy Massey Riley, Tammie Massey Elms, Jason Ernest Massey Stubbs, Justin Edgar Stubbs, Courtney Lynn Massey and Brittney Michelle Massey; two step-grandchildren, Chris Coursey and Dawn Coursey; four great-grandchildren, Amanda and Ashley Stoltz, Jean Ann Riley and Taylor Elms; and three step great-grandchildren, Cole and Alex Coursey and Chelsea Bowden. He was preceded in death by his wife of 55 years, Lula Mae Massey in March 2001.
