



Esther Skinner Medinger

March 11, 1923 - March 1, 2015

Esther Skinner Medinger of Easton, MD, died on March 1, 2015. She was 91.

Born in Easton on March 11, 1923, she was one of the twelve children of the late John Jesse Mullikin and Susan Ethel Benson Skinner. Esther attended Hillsboro Elementary School and then graduated from Tri-County High School in Queen Anne, MD, in 1940. She then attended Goldey-Beacom Business College in Wilmington, DE, until 1944. The former Ms. Skinner served in the Women's Army Corps (WAC) from December 22, 1944 until June 15, 1946, when she was honorably discharged. During this time, she earned the rank of T/4 and worked as an assistant physical therapist in the Medical Corps. Mrs. Medinger retired after working for more than 20 years as a steno-clerk for Fruit Growers Express Company in Baltimore, MD.

On February 4, 1956, she married G. Ferd Medinger, Jr., who preceded her in death on May 30, 1995.

She is survived by her brother, S. Eugene (Julie), of Harrington, DE; and numerous nieces and nephews. In addition to her husband, she was preceded in death by her siblings, Benson, Herman, William T., Leroy, Gilbert, Catherine, Elsie, Louise, Ruth, and Gloria.

A funeral service will be held at 12 p.m. on Monday, March 9, at the Fellows,

Helpfenbein & Newnam Funeral Home, P.A. in Centreville, MD, where friends and family may visit beginning at 11 a.m. Burial will follow in Chesterfield Cemetery, Centreville, MD.
