Esther “Patti” Patricia Taylor of Collinsville, OK, formerly of Chestertown, MD, died Saturday, September 23, 2017, while visiting her family in Chestertown. She was 44.

Esther “Patti” Taylor was born August 6, 1973, in Chestertown, MD, the daughter of Patricia Murphy and the late William Simns.
