Esther Marie Steward Clark, of Bridgewater, VA, formerly of Easton, MD, died at the Bridgewater Home, Bridgewater, on May 2, 2001. She was 81.

Born in Talbot County, September 17, 1919, she was the daughter of the late John Lincoln and Elsie Etta Spicher Steward. After graduating from high school, she moved to Wilmington, DE where she attended Goldie Beacom Business College. On February 14, 1942, she married Robert Ruthven Clark in Wilmington, DE and, after his discharge from the U. S. Army, they returned to Talbot County to live until moving to Bridgewater in April of 1998.

Very active in the Peachblossom Church of the Brethren in Easton where she served on various committees and taught Adult Sunday School, she was also a camp counselor at Camp Mardela in Denton for many years. Mrs. Clark served as Secretary of the Country Women of the World, President of the Maryland Co-operative Extension Service and the President of the National Extension Homemaker's Council and in those capacities traveled all over the United States and the world addressing and experiencing various cultures.

Mr. Clark died on March 16, 2000.

Mrs. Clark is survived by two daughters, Lynn Clark Heatwole of Harrisonburg,

VA and Esther C. Stempel of Lawrenceville, VA; a son, The Rev. Robert R. Clark, Jr. of Bridgewater, VA; three loving sisters, Marjorie S. Walbridge of Easton, MD, Dorothy S. Miller, of Richmond, VA and Louise S. Mahan of Salisbury, MD; two brothers, Ralph Steward of Gambrills, MD and William Steward of Easton, MD; seven grandchildren and two great-grandchildren. A brother, Earl Steward, is deceased.

Funeral services will be held on Monday, May 7th, at 2 P.M. at the Easton Church of the Brethren, Easton, MD where friends may call one hour prior to service.

Burial will be at the Fairview Church of the Brethren Cemetery, Cordova. MD.
