Ethel May Lucas Everett of Chestertown, MD, died at Chester River Hospital on Monday, April 22, 2013. She was 90.

Born in Wye Island, MD, on August 26, 1922, she was the daughter of the late Bradford Lucas and Vallie Chance Lucas. She graduated Church Hill High School with the Class of 1939 and began with the Church Hill Bank in 1942. She worked for 40 years in banking and retired as department head of cash management in 1985. She lived in Church Hill where she raised her son before moving to Chestertown in 1970.

She enjoyed counted cross stitching, going on cruises, traveling, cooking, and being with her family. She was a member of the Church Hill United Methodist Church.
