



## Ethel Sherwood Goldsborough

November 4, 1935 - November 28, 2024

In the morning hours of November 28, 2024, Ethel was found resting at peace at her home in Easton, MD. She blessed the world with 89 years of life. She was surrounded by love and the quiet beauty of the life she so cherished. Like the birds she adored and the gentle rhythms of nature that she held close to her heart, her departure was serene and full of grace.

Born November 4, 1935, to Hazel and James Sherwood, Ethel spent her life journey in Talbot County. Ethel was the oldest of four children and graduated from Easton High School in 1954. After graduation, Ethel began her work as an assistant in a local doctor's office. In 1958, she married the love of her life, Buzz. The two built their family on the Miles River, and in 1976 moved to Longwoods. Ethel stayed at home to raise her two children. When her children became school aged, she went to work as a first grade teaching assistant for Talbot County Board of Education. Years later, she worked as a periodontal assistant for Dr. Dale Wood, and then as a chairside assistant for Dr. George Dent.

Ethel was a genuinely kind woman. She found joy in simple acts of generosity. Whether it was baking to share with others, gardening, watching the birds at the feeder in her yard, or just being present with others. She was a willing listener, especially to her granddaughters. Always known to take care of others including a stray cat, Charlie, who made daily visits to her doorstep.

Ethel in recent years enjoyed watching the youthful side of her 6 great grandchildren with awe and endless love. She marveled at their milestones, delighted in their laughter, and celebrated their triumphs, big and small. Her stories, hugs, and wisdom will live on in their hearts, a legacy of love that transcends time.

Ethel found peace and meaning in the world around her, from the rustling leaves in the wind to the songs of the birds that often perched nearby. Her life was a testament to the beauty of simplicity, the strength of family, and the power of love.

Ethel has reunited with her mother and father, her brother James "Shorty" Sherwood, son Keith "Bunky" Goldsborough, and many other family and friends that preceded her death.

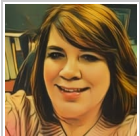
