Ethel Knox Irions, 88, of St. Michaels, Md, passed away on Sunday, December 16, 2018, at the University of Maryland Shore Medical Center in Easton, MD.

She was born in 1930 in Caribou, ME, the daughter of the late Lyman Burrill Knox and Hazel Shorey Knox. She was preceded in death by her husband, Major General (USAF) Charles Carter Irions; three brothers, Phillip, Milton, and Lyman, Jr.; and one sister, Phyllis Knox Squiers. She is survived by one son, Jonathan Knox Irions of Fort Collins, CO; one daughter, Leslie Irions McKahan of Davenport, FL; and one granddaughter, Molly McKahan Garcia and her husband, Dorian of Amarillo, TX.

She was also very much involved in Little Theatre activities and was often called “the resident poet,” toastmaster, and skit writer for awards banquets and social occasions. She was also active in her church fundraising events and was an avid bridge player.
