Ethel Sewell Bennett of Dover, Delaware, formerly of Chestertown, MD died on October 17, 2004 at Capitol Healthcare in Dover. She was 81.

Born in Queenstown, MD on April 25, 1923, she was the daughter of the late James Kersey and Julia M. Young Sewell. Following the untimely death of her parents she was raised by Rolph and Louise Glenn Stoops. She attended school in Fairlee, Maryland and on December 14, 1940 she married Roland Bennett.

They resided in Broadneck until moving to Chestertown in 1955. She was primarily a homemaker, raising her six sons along with several grandchildren. Mrs. Bennett operated Ethel's Adult Foster Care, three adult care facilities, for over 10 years.
