Ethel Rose Weaver Studham of Grayslake, IL, formerly of Stevensville, MD, died on July 7, 2016, at Wauconda Health Care. She was 98. Born November 20, 1917, in Newton, IA, she was the daughter of the late Rose McCoy and Lyrnan Weaver.

Ethel graduated from Newton High School in Newton. She married Edward Studham on May 29, 1938. While Ed served in WWII, Ethel moved to Chicago. After the war they settled in Oak Park, IL, where Ethel worked as a secretary before retiring in 1984.

They later moved to Easton, MD, to live closer to their grandchildren. Ethel was an active member of Easton Presbyterian Church, loved to sing in the choir, and worked part-time at Talbot Hospice. In the summer of 2005, she moved to Stevensville, MD, and joined the Kent Island United Methodist Church.

Ethel was very active into her 90's. She enjoyed line dancing, playing cards, and shopping and was an active member of the Red Hat Society. Ethel loved hosting family celebrations and holiday dinners. In February 2012, she moved to assisted living in Wauconda, IL.

She is survived by her sons, Robert E. Studham (Mary) of Glen Burnie, MD,

and Bruce W. Studham (Harriet) of Grayslake, IL; six grandchildren; and eight great-grandchildren.

In addition to her parents, she was preceded in death by her husband, Edward J. Studham, in 1988 and seven siblings.

A memorial service will be at 11 a.m. on Thursday, July 21, 2016, at Fellows, Helfenbein & Newnam Funeral Home, P.A. in Chester, MD. Burial will follow at 2 p.m. at the Eastern Shore Veterans Cemetery in Hurlock, MD.
