January 5, 1938 - October 31, 2022

Ethel Patricia Weishaar "Pat" passed away on October 31, 2022. She was 84 years old.

Pat was born in Annapolis on January 5, 1938, to the late Arthur Adrian Burns and the former Sarah Lillian Wood.

Pat was a native Annapolitan/Eastporter and proud graduate of Annapolis High School, Class of 1956. She excelled in business class, an accomplished and very fast typist.

Her early career was secretarial work in Annapolis at Nationwide Insurance alongside her best friend Linda (Blair) Paepcke, bookkeeping at the US Naval Academy, and writing/typing contracts at Universal Motors before joining Anne Arundel County Public Schools in the early 1970s. She enjoyed bird watching in her back yard and really all wildlife especially at the dog park with her beloved Bruiser, Penny, and Elsie. In retirement, Pat was an avid reader, loved playing card games with her grandkids; attending Shotgun Bingo at the Kent Island Elks with her sisters, watching her soap opera, and chasing a big win on scratch-offs or the Lottery.
