Ethel Harrison Asche of Easton, MD, formerly of Cordova, died at Genesis Health Care the Pines on Thursday, December 20, 2007. She was 80.

Born in Claiborne, MD on August 14, 1927, she was the daughter of the late Earl and Sadie Callis Harrison. After graduating from Talbot County public schools she attended and graduated from Wesley College in Dover, DE. In 1946, she married Carl G. Asche and they made their home in Cordova. She began a career as a secretary/ bookkeeper in the broiler division which was then known as the J. Mc Kenny Willis and Sons Company, which later became Bay Shores Foods and finally Con-agra. In 1973, following her retirement she opened Granny's Workshop in Cordova, where she was known for her detailed quilting and crafts. Mr. Asche died May 3, 2001.

A member of the Immanuel Lutheran Church in Easton, Mrs. Asche served as a substitute organist, and also sang at weddings and other special occasions.

Affectionately she was known as a feisty strong willed person who always kept people on their toes.

She is survived by a daughter, Jeannette Asche of Easton, a son, Earle Asche and his wife Catherine of Cordova, five grandchildren: Ronnie Cheesum, Jr., Michele Bradley, Will, Lindsey, and Eric Asche, four great-grandchildren:

Brittany, Tamara, Brandon, and Jessica, and three step-great-grandchildren: Kelly, Kayla, and Jacob.
