Ethel M. Turner, of Easton, died at Memorial Hospital at Easton on Monday, July 19, 2004. She was 66.

Born in Salisbury, MD September 16, 1937, she was the daughter of the late John Elton and Lillian Johnson Mason. After graduating from Pocomoke High School and Marjorie Webster Junior College, in Washington D.C., she taught kindergarten in Salisbury. She then hosted her own live show, "Aunt Mary's Birthday Party", on WBOC-TV. She subsequently moved to Talbot County where she enjoyed a successful career as a realtor; receiving the Distinguished Sales Representative of the Year in 1984 by the Talbot County Board of Realtors. For the last ten years she owned and operated "The Party Center" costume and party rental and supply store until failing health required her to close the business.

Active in the community, she was a member of St. Andrew – the-Seafarer Chapel (Anglican) in Easton, was a founding member and Past President of the Talbot Soroptomists Club; was a past member of the Talbot County Chamber of Commerce and the Talbot County Board of Realtors. An accomplished sailor, she was also a former member of the Tred Avon Yacht Club.

Mrs. Turner is survived by her husband, Henry P. Turner whom she married November 27, 1970; a step-son, H. Powell Turner, of Easton; a sister, Anne Mason, of Accomac, VA and two brothers, John Marshall Mason, of Ambridge, PA and Jay Elton Mason, of Hagerstown, MD.

Private funeral services will be held at the graveside at the Maryland Eastern Shore Veterans Cemetery, Beulah.
