



## Ethel S. Bryan

Ethel S. Bryan of Trappe, MD was dead on arrival at the Dorchester General Hospital, Cambridge on Wednesday, June 6, 2001 after suffering an apparent heart attack at her home. She was 69.

Born in Easton, March 26, 1932, she was the daughter of the late Henry M., Sr. and Margaret Eshem Shortall. After graduating from Easton High School in 1951, she, on November 12, 1952, married William W. Bryan, a Trappe area farmer. They made their home on the farm near Bruceville where she assisted her husband in its daily operation. Her husband died in March of 1992.

A member of the Faith Chapel United Methodist Church at Bruceville, Trappe, she was also a member of the Ladies of the Elks, Easton Lodge #1622.

Mrs. Bryan is survived by; a brother, Henry Michael Shortall, Jr. of Easton; two nephews, William O. Shortall, Sr., of Trappe and Henry M. Shortall, III of Easton; a niece, Kay Wilkins of Easton and a sister-in-law, Dorothy Phelps of Easton.
