



Eugene Elsworth Beall

September 6, 1933 - June 24, 2022

Eugene “Gene” Elsworth Beall, age 88, passed away peacefully, surrounded by family on June 24, 2022.

A 17-year resident of Easton, Maryland, Gene was born and raised in Washington, DC to the late Wellington Chapman Beall and Myrtle Lusby Beall. He graduated from Eastern High School in 1952.

Gene honorably served in the United States Air Force as a Staff Sgt. in Korea from 1952 - 1956. Upon returning home, he graduated from Capital Radio Engineering Institute. He met and married his sweetheart, Rachel Connors on June 5, 1959. They spent 63 years celebrating life together.

Gene’s early career as an electronics equipment specialist took him to Florida where he worked installing the Eglin Gulf Testing Range, to Texas, and then to New Mexico where he worked installing the White Sands Missile Range.

Gene spent most of his career working for the National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration (NOAA) in Maryland and retired in 1989 after 32 years of government service. Gene was on loan for two years to the United Nations and moved his growing family to the island of Barbados from 1967 - 1969. There he was responsible for procuring contracts for electronic equipment and training personnel for the Caribbean Meteorological Institute.

Gene had a lifelong love of travel and the great outdoors. Many vacations

were spent camping and exploring. His motto was “it’s not the destination, it’s the journey.” He enjoyed hunting, fishing, crabbing, planting a summer garden, and most of all RVing, trying to visit all 50 states and many national parks. He was devoted to his family and was known for his quick wit and “grandad jokes”.

Gene is survived by his loving wife, Rachel Beall; his children, Esther Fowble (Doug) of Lewes, DE, Terri Sanders (Mark) of Owings, MD, Bruce Beall (Darlene) of Bishopville, MD; and grandchildren Daniel Price, Alexander Price (Elaine), Patrick Price, Bethany Sanders, Nicholas Sanders, Chloe Beall and Grady Beall.

He was preceded in death by his sister, Lorraine Hopkins, and his grandson, Thomas Price IV.

Gene was a member of First Baptist Church in Easton, MD, and was very active with Gideons International for many years.

A visitation will be held at First Baptist Church of Easton on Monday July 18, 2022 from 11 - 12 pm with a funeral service to follow.
