



Eugene Michaelovich Cherewko

February 18, 1938 - July 3, 2017

Eugene Michaelovich Cherewko of Queen Anne, MD, died on Monday, July 3, 2017. He was 79.

Born in Ukraine on February 18, 1938, Eugene was the son of the late Michael and Luba (Trutowska) Cherewko.

In 1949, Eugene and his family immigrated to the US, where they worked extremely hard to save money to purchase the family farm in Queen Anne in 1954.

Eugene attended Queen Anne Elementary School and later graduated from Centreville High School in 1957. In continuing his education, he attended the former Towson State College and graduated in 1961 with a Master's Degree in Education. He earned an additional Master's Degree in Education from Loyola College in 1973. After graduation, Eugene was a Science/Math teacher at Stemmers Run Middle School in Essex, MD.

After retirement, he built his home on the Cherewko Family Farm where he enjoyed tending to his expansive garden, especially his tomato plants. He was also a cooking enthusiast and enjoyed preparing many wonderful meals for his family.

He is survived by his wife, Josephine Cherewko; two daughters, Tanya Maguire and Larisa Frankoski; a son, Gregory Cherewko; a sister, Nadia Schlotzhauer; five granddaughters; and one grandson. In addition to his parents, he was preceded in death by his sister, Tamara Petroff.

A Ukrainian Orthodox funeral service will be held on Saturday, July 8, 2017, at 3 PM at Fellows, Helfenbein and Newnam Funeral Home, P.A. 200 S. Harrison St., Easton, MD 21601, where friends may call one hour prior. Burial to follow at Spring Hill Cemetery.
