After a lengthy illness, Eugene Nevitt Cheezum of Bethlehem, MD finally got to make his journey Home on Thursday, March 16, 2006. He was 74.

Born December 1, 1931 in Easton, MD, he was the son of the late William Walton "Cutter" and Wilhemina Fisher "Minnie" Cheezum. He attended school in Talbot County and during the Korean Conflict, he served in the U.S. Army. After his release from active duty, he began a life-long career in carpentry and small engine repair.
