



Eugene Oliver "Chick" Legg, Jr.

September 28, 1930 - April 8, 2010

Eugene O. Legg, Jr., who all his life was known as "Chick", died on Thursday, April 8, 2010 at Memorial Hospital in Easton. He was 79 years old.

Chick was born on September 28, 1930 on a farm in Castle Marina, Chester, MD to the late, E. Oliver and Nataline Hunter Legg. He was a 1949 graduate of Stevensville High School. On April 12, 1952, Chick married Charlotte Conley. While raising their family, Chick worked on the family farm and on the water. In the 1970's, Chick and Charlotte owned and operated the Waterman's Inn and then Legg's Drive- Through Liquor Store. They retired in 1994. Chick was Honorary Past Governor and still active in Bay Country Moose. In the 1980's and 1990's, he traveled with the Moose Shuffleboard team to various taverns and won many titles. Chick's wife, Charlotte, passed away in June 2004.

He is survived by his children, Bob(Theresa), Bonnie (JC), Gene(Bonney), Chris(Emily) and Charlene; his grandchildren, Gene(Dina), Courtney, Marci, Bambi(Kenny), Megan, John, Lacy, Lindsey, and Korin; fourteen great-grandchildren, Cody, Mya, Calay, Alexa, Dakota, Skylar, Shelby, Jaxson, Nick, Gabe, Lilly, Brooklyn, Colbin and Kyle; two daughter-in-laws, Virginia and Edie; and three step grandchildren, Jason, Jen and Katie. Chick is also survived by his brother and sister-in-law, John and Ruth Legg of Church Hill and by his sister, Betty Tolson of Chester. He is predeceased by a sister, Julia "Sis" Hardesty and a brother, Bob Legg.

The family will receive family and friends at Fellows, Helfenbein & Newnam Funeral Home in Chester, MD on Monday, April 12, 2010 at 2:00pm for a memorial service officiated by Bobby Timms. 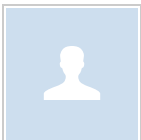
