Eunice Eleanor Tolson of Chester, MD, died Saturday, October 22, 2011, at University of Maryland Shock Trauma Center. She was 84.

Born in Chester, MD, on March 27, 1927, she was the daughter of the late Leonard and Ellen Elizabeth Livingston Hoxter. She graduated from Stevensville High School, Class of 1946. She met and married Harry Wrightson Tolson in 1946, and they raised their five children in Chester.
