



Eustis H. Thompson

Eustis Henry Thompson of Rock Hall, MD died on Saturday, July 12, 2003 at Chester River Hospital Center in Chestertown, MD. He was 82.

Born in Pittsburgh, PA on September 30, 1920, he was the son of the late Eustis H. Sr. and Marion Ancker Thompson.

Mr. Thompson grew up in Rock Hall, MD and lived all of his life there. He attended public schools then served stateside in the U.S. Army during WWII. He was honorably discharged in 1943. Returning to Rock Hall he worked as a waterman, farmer, garage mechanic, and in a sawmill. Mr. Thompson was an excellent carpenter. He also delivered the Kent County News and for many years Mr. Thompson owned and operated a hauling business and for twenty years he carried the mail twice daily from Rock Hall to Chestertown.

Having had a difficult childhood, he always helped those in need, no matter how little he had. He was keenly interested in family history and most recently the restoration of a room in the original family mansion in Clifton Park in Baltimore, MD.

Mr. Thompson was a devoted orioles fan and enjoyed the scenic roads of Kent County.

He was also a member of Salem United Methodist Church in Fairlee.

Mr. Thompson is survived by a sister, Mrs. Virginia T. Merryman and her husband, Nicholas B. Merryman III. He was pre-deceased by a brother, Walter Ancker Thompson.

A memorial service will be held on Thursday, July 17, 2003 at 11:00 AM at Salem United Methodist Church in Fairlee, MD. Interment will be held privately in the adjoining cemetery.
