Eva Elizabeth Foreman died on November 24, 2016, at the University of Maryland Shore Medical Center at Easton. She was 91.

Born on October 6, 1925, in Trappe, MD, she was the daughter of the late Alfred Eugene and Edith Moore Coleman.

Eva graduated from Easton High School in 1944 and married Roland E. Foreman in 1950. She was employed as a waitress at Old Oak Hill Diner, Rollie Tea Shop, H& G Restaurant, and Waverly Press. Eva worked at the Memorial Hospital at Easton in central supply retiring in 1995 with 24 years of service. Eva was a life member of the Easton Church of God and was a very active member in the VFW # 5118, Ladies Auxiliary in Easton, serving as president and chaplain.

She is survived by three children, Janice L. Abbott (Richard) of Easton, Robin Lynne (David) Gucinski, and Roland Terry Foreman, all of Selbyville, DE; five grandchildren; and nine great-grandchildren. In addition to her husband, Roland E. Foreman, who died in 2008, she was preceded in death by her son, Gregory Lance Foreman, and her siblings; Betty Lavery, John William Wilson Jackson, Edward Marvin Jackson, and Kenneth Scott Jackson.
