July 20, 1920 - August 12, 2016

Eva North Hubbard of Easton, MD, passed away on Friday, August 12, 2016, at Heartfields Assisted Living. She was 96.

Mrs. Hubbard was born on July 20, 1920, on Tilghman Island, to the late Robert Risdon and Effie Tarr North.

On July 11, 1941, she married Nathan H. Hubbard at the United Methodist Parsonage in Easton, MD. Mr. Hubbard passed away on April 30, 1968.

Mrs. Hubbard was well-known in the community. She was a Charter Member of St. Mark's UMC in Easton, a lifetime member of the Ladies of the Elks, a member of the Talbot County Women's Club, and an avid bridge player. One of her fondest memories was creating a recording of the history and lifestyle of Talbot County. This recording is kept at the Talbot County Library. Due to Mrs. Hubbard's drive and strong work ethic, she was recognized as the First Female Deputy Treasurer of the State of Maryland. In addition to being active in the community, Mrs. Hubbard enjoyed gardening, traveling, and power boating with her daughter and son-in-law.

Mrs. Hubbard is survived by her children, daughter, Dianne H. VanSlambrook (Richard), of Easton, MD, and son Richard N. Hubbard (Karen) of Arnold, MD; brother, Robert North of Pasadena, MD; six grandchildren; and 12 great-

grandchildren.

In addition to her parents, Mrs. Hubbard was predeceased by two brothers, Norman North, Senator John-Clarence North and a sister, Edna Henry.
