Eva Zajac of Wye Mills, MD died Friday, April 9, 2010 surrounded by her family at Corsica Hills Nursing Center in Centerville, MD. She was 88.

Born on March 2, 1922 in Ukraine the daughter of the late, Michael Opryszko and Mary Korostenska she grew up in Ukraine and later moved to Germany during WW II as Germany occupied Ukraine. During the war she worked as farm help where she met Atanzij Zajac. They fell in love and would not be able to marry until the war ended. On June 26, 1945 they married and were classified as displaced people as a result of WW II and were offered to come to the United States in January of 1949. They arrived in Baltimore and soon found employment with Herbert Carter as farm help. As her husband worked on the farms she was a homemaker as they resided in Wye Mills, MD.

Eva loved gardening especially with flowers, listening to music and spending time with her family.

She is survived by her husband of 64 years, Atanzij Zajac of Wye Mills; MD two sons, Walter Zajac and his wife, Bonnie of Denton, MD and Michael Zajac and his wife, Elise of Queenstown, MD; three grandchildren, Mickey Zajac, Ashley Zajac and Troy Knotts and three great grandchildren, Kayla & Roman Knotts and Kylee Zajac.

A funeral mass will be held 11AM Wednesday, April 14, 2010 at St. Peter's Catholic Church in Queenstown, MD where interment will follow in St. Peter's Cemetery.
