



Evalyn Nesbitt Washburn Jr.

January 26, 1924 - November 18, 2013

Evalyn Nesbitt Washburn, Jr., formerly of St. Michaels, died Monday, November 18, 2013. She was 89 years old.

Evalyn was born in Larchmont, New York on January 6, 1924. She was the daughter of Frank S. Washburn and Evalyn Nesbitt Washburn. She attended Rye Country Day School in Rye, New York. She graduated from the Mannes School of Music an accomplished singer and pianist. She spent many hours designing a sweater for the McCalls Knitting Magazine in the 1970's. While living in New York, she loved Broadway Shows and attended with her mother more than 75 of them. She was a member of the American Red Cross during World War II. Evalyn rolled bandages and hosted servicemen on weekend leaves to aid the war effort. Evalyn recalled watching the Rockettes practice on the roof of the building next door to her father's office at Rockefeller Center.

Evalyn spent 80 summers in Yarmouth, Nova Scotia in Canada. They owned a summer home that was named the Gulls and she grew up wandering the shores. As an adult, she learned to play golf in Canada and fondly remembered that the mayor had been her caddy. She enjoyed watching the sun set over the water from her living room window. Evalyn enjoyed showing visitors around Yarmouth and was a great historian.

The family moved to St. Michaels in the early 1960's. A retirement home was built on Drum Point Road named Far Horizons. Evalyn lived there until 2005. She gave piano lessons to children and learned to ride horses on the farm that is now The Inn at Perry Cabin. Anything that Evalyn decided to do, she learned easily. She was an avid photographer. Evalyn traveled extensively and had been to Europe many times. Italian was her second language, she could speak it fluently as well as read it. She enjoyed having lunch with the Lunch Bunch Ladies of Drum Point. Dessert of any kind was her favorite food.

Evalyn's parents preceded her in death. She is survived by one cousin, Virginia Haydu of Asbury Park, New Jersey.

A graveside service will be held on Friday, November 22, 2013 at 11am at Hopewell Cemetery in Port Deposit, MD.
