Evans Rodney Kessler "Rod" died at the Hospice House, Centreville, MD on Thursday, January 14, 2010. He was 83.

Born to the late, Walter Evans and Myrtle Selma Kessler in Englewood , NJ on July 9, 1926. He attended school in Dumont, NJ and was drafted into the U.S. Army in 1944. Mr. Kessler served in Europe in the Tank 772 Tan Battalion in the Rhineland Campaign. He returned home in 1946 and attended Rhodes Prep School to finish his studies. In 1948 he married Avis Lorraine Ryerson. Mr. Kessler was a uniformed firefighter of the Bergenfield, NJ Fire Department, retiring in 1983 with 28 years of service.

Mr. Kessler is a life member of the Alert Fire Company and the Prospect Fire Company of Bergenfield, NJ. He is also an associate member of the Goodwill Fire Company of Centreville, MD. He is a member of VFW #7464 in Grasonville, MD and the American Legion, Post #18 of Centreville, MD. Mr. Kessler is a member of the Centreville United Methodist Church and the United Methodist Men. He is a former member of the Kent Island Yacht Club and a former member of the Civil Air Patrol.

Mr. Kessler is survived by his wife, Avis Lorraine Kessler; three children, Robert Evans Kessler and wife, Joyce Sutcliffe of West Newton, MA, Laurie Adele Cummins and husband, David of Emerson, NJ and Lynn Avis Kessler

and husband Eric Meyer of Bloomsbury, NJ; six grandchildren, Ryan Evans Kessler, Adam David Kessler, Tonya Sutcliffe, Katrina Sutcliffe, Nicole Lynn Meyer and Brent Evans Meyer. His brother, Donald B. Kessler and wife, Patricia of Ohio. A sister, Joan Kessler predeceased him.

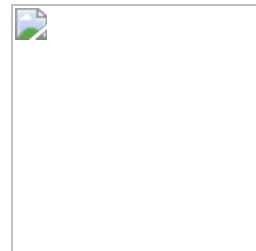
