October 7, 1924 - May 30, 2013

Evelyn Eberhard of Easton, MD, died surrounded by family at Seasons Hospice, Northwest Hospital, Randallstown, MD, on Thursday, May 30, 2013. She was 88 years old.

Born October 7, 1924 in Preston, MD, she was the daughter of the late Edward A. Schmick and Clara Frase Schmick. Evelyn was a graduate of Federalsburg High School and Baltimore Business College. She married the late Herman W. Eberhard on September, 21, 1946.

Evelyn was a very loving wife, mother, grandmother, and great-grandmother. She loved spending time with her family and friends, reading and spending time outdoors enjoying God's creation.

Together with her husband, they owned and operated Bill's News and Variety Store in Easton, MD for ten years. Evelyn then became the manager of the Harbor Club, where she worked for twenty years. She was a faithful member of Immanuel Lutheran Church in Easton, MD, for over sixty years, where she served as a member of The Ladies Aid, the Altar Guild, and the building committee.

She is survived by a daughter, Marilyn Heinemann and her husband Charles, a daughter-in-law, Peggy Eberhard, also four grandchildren; Paul W.

Heinemann (Jessica), Chris Eberhard (Sara), Dave Heinemann (Lindsey), Jennifer Eberhard, and seven great-grandchildren. In addition to her husband, she was preceded in death by a son, Mark Eberhard.
