Evelyn Ann King (née Wehberg) of Centreville, MD, passed away at her home on Sunday, September 28, 2025, at the age of 86.

Born on Valentine's Day, February 14, 1939, in Baltimore, MD, Evelyn was the beloved daughter of the late Edward and Margaret Wehberg. In 1957, while still at Southern High School (her alma mater), Evelyn eloped with her lifelong partner and best friend, Jim. Married on April 5, 1957, they shared 61 beautiful years together, building not only a marriage but a family that was always at the heart of Evelyn's world. Their journey together took them from Baltimore to Columbia, SC for their Army years, before moving to Glen Burnie, and finally settling on the beautiful Maryland Eastern Shore in 1975.

Evelyn devoted her early years to raising her children and creating a home filled with warmth, traditions, and unconditional love. She delighted in family gatherings, holiday celebrations, and the simple, everyday moments that became treasured memories. She was happiest surrounded by those she loved, whether preparing a favorite meal, tidying the home for a family gathering, sharing laughter around the table, or taking trips to the beach, which she always cherished.

Once her youngest daughter reached school age, Evelyn began her career at Nationwide Insurance, as a claims adjuster. Over her 25-year tenure, she was

a multi-year member of the “Millionaire Club”, collecting more than \$1 million in subrogation claims in a year, and advancing her career throughout that time.

The most constant and defining part of her life was the way she gave her whole heart to her family. Her proudest role was always being a wife, mother, grandmother, and great-grandmother. Her family was her greatest joy, and the love and devotion she poured into them remain her most enduring legacy. Her greatest love was her husband, Jim, who predeceased her in 2018. She is survived by her loving children Kerry King (Jerry) and Mark King (Lisa) of Centreville, MD, James E. King of Chestertown, and Judy Nelson (Randy) of Reisterstown, MD; her eight grandchildren Sarah King, Alexandria Ofer (Adam), Stefanie Clayton (David), Phillip Nelson, Brittany Battaglia (James), Matthew King (Keniesha), Clarke Jewell, and Owen Jewell; and many great-grandchildren, nieces, and nephews.
