Evelyn Maria Schaub, Age 90, passed away peacefully, surrounded by her loving family, on August 19, 2026. Beautiful, intelligent, and thoughtful, Evelyn was a devoted wife, mother, grandmother, great-grandmother, sister, and friend.

Born on July 11, 1936, in Washington, D.C., to Amelia and Frank Gallo, Evelyn grew up in Maryland and graduated from Suitland High School, where she was a cheerleader and was inducted into the National Honor Society.

Evelyn met Bill Schaub through her brother Rudy, a friend of Bill's. Their relationship grew through letters she wrote to Bill while he served in the U.S. Navy. They married and shared 66 happy years together. They settled in Forestville, Maryland, where they raised their three children, later lived in Sterling, Virginia, and after retirement made their home in Ocean Pines, Maryland.

Evelyn worked for the Press Relations Wire Service in Washington, D.C., and later supported the U.S. Senate Committee on Agriculture on Capitol Hill. She spoke proudly of supporting both Democrats and Republicans in her work there. Evelyn maintained a lifelong interest in politics and public affairs and was active in local Democratic Party groups throughout her life.

Evelyn had a gift for hospitality, and her home was often filled with family, friends, and good food. An excellent cook, she kept family traditions alive, especially at the holidays. Her Catholic faith was important to her, and Sunday Mass was a regular part of her life. She also loved flowers and creating a beautiful and welcoming home.

Evelyn is survived by her three children, Laura (Rick) Hazzard, W. Gregory (Patti) Schaub, and Sharon (David) Nichols; six grandchildren, Rick (Jennifer) Hazzard, David (Coral) Nichols, Alison (John) McGrimley, Jennifer (Lee) Ballard, W. Charlie (Subha) Schaub, and Stanley Schaub; and twelve great-grandchildren. She is also survived by her sister-in-law, Sue (Tom) Delaney, and her dearest friend, Julia (Fred) Stewart.

She was preceded in death by her beloved husband, Bill; her parents, Amelia and Frank Gallo; and her brothers, Rudy Gallo and Frank Gallo Jr.
