



Evelyn Theresa Torraca

March 31, 1929 - September 9, 2017

Evelyn T. Torraca, 88, died peacefully on September 9, 2017, at Talbot Hospice House in Easton, MD.

Born on March 31, 1929, in New York, NY, she was the daughter of the late William Hoerbinger and Charlotte Suender Hoerbinger. She attended Walton High School, graduating Class of 1946. Evelyn began working at Guardian Life Insurance Company for the medical director. On May 3, 1952, she married Nicholas R. Torraca, and they lived in Brooklyn, NY. They later moved to Long Island in 1955, Marlboro, NJ, in 1968 and came to Maryland in 1985, moving to Neavitt. While living in Marlboro, NJ, she began working for the federal government in electronic warfare as a secretary. She retired in 1984.

Mrs. Torraca was a brailleist, certified by the Library of Congress. She wrote braille for the Industrial Home for the Blind in New York and in Talbot County. She was a very active member of the Maritime Museum and enjoyed painting and collecting seashells.

Mrs. Torraca is survived by her husband of 65 years, Nicholas R. Torraca; their three children, Richard Torraca and wife Michele, Margaret Benjamin and Kathryn Butler and husband, Douglas; four grandchildren, Richard, Alicia, Erika and Larissa Torraca; and three great-grandchildren.

A memorial mass will be held on Saturday, September 16, 2017, at 10 a.m. at Sts. Peter & Paul Catholic Church, 1210 S. Washington St. in Easton. Interment will be at St. Joseph's Cemetery in Cordova, MD.

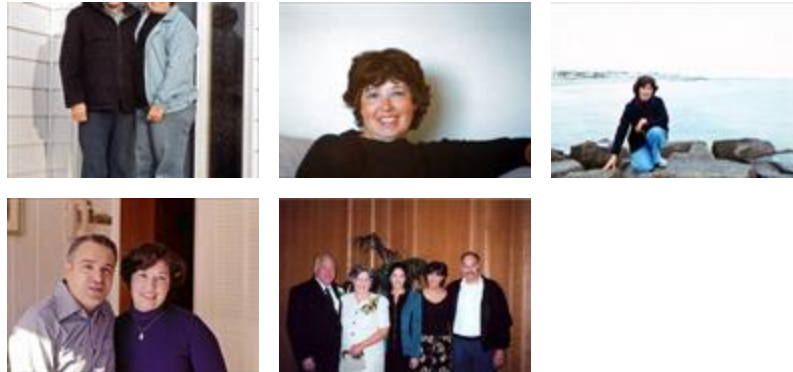
