Evelyn Louise Cropp Westfall, 90, of Ocean City, MD, went home to be with the Lord on August 23, 2016. She has resided in Easton, MD, over the past year, due to failing health, spending her final days at the Talbot Hospice House.

Evelyn was born to the late Herman and Blanche Cropp, February 1, 1926, in Richmond, VA. She married Henry Bryan Westfall on July 20, 1946. They were members of St. Peter's Lutheran Church in Ocean City, MD.

Evelyn was a devoted wife, mother, grandmother, and great-grandmother. Evelyn was pre-deceased by her husband, Henry Bryan Westfall. She recently lost her sister, Jeanne Borden of Waldorf, MD. Evelyn leaves behind half-
