Evelyn Bouma Hamilton, fondly known as "E", died Monday, November 15, 2010. She was 100.

Born in Maywood, Illinois, one of ten children, she came to Washington, D.C., in 1941 to work for the War Production Board. She was married to Robert Bouma of Washington until his death in 1972. She lived in Bethesda. Evelyn moved to the Eastern Shore in 1993 where she met and married George Hamilton of Salisbury. He died in 1998.

She is survived by her daughter, Susan Deerin and husband, Dick of Oxford; her son, Richard Bouma of Springfield, VA; three grandsons and their wives, JB and Meghan Deerin of Washington, Sloan and Missy Deerin of Chevy Chase, and Andrew and Christine Deerin of Redondo Beach, CA; and nine great-grandchildren, Lilly, Lucy, Devon, Tess, Jack, James, Kingsley, Grace and Ford.
