Evelyn Usilton Councill of Chestertown, MD died at the Hospice Center, Centreville, MD on Tuesday, December 28, 2010. She was 88.

Born on August 31, 1922 in Lynch, MD, she was the daughter of the late, Robert L. and Florence Keyser Usilton. She attended Chestertown High School and graduated in the Class of 1939. On November 3, 1942 she married Marion A. Councill of Cordova, MD.
