Loving wife & mother, Florence Ann Donohue of Queenstown, MD, died Saturday January 13, 2001, at her home. She was 63.

Born on September 16, 1937, in Long Branch, NJ, she was the daughter of the late Moore R. Castin & Martha F. Tucker Castin. She was a graduate of Red Bank Catholic High School in Red Bank, NJ. She was a graduate of Monmouth University in West Long Branch, NJ, where she received her B.S. in Mathematics in June of 1960. From 1960 ~ 1962, she worked for U.S. Navy Engineering Test Facility in Lakehurst, NJ, and in 1962 ~ 1963 for the U.S. Army Munitions Command in Piccatinny Arsenal, NJ, as a mathematician.

She married Bart P. Donohue, III, in 1962 and became a homemaker as they resided in Madison & Rumson, NJ. In 1994, they moved to Queenstown, MD. She was an active member of the Parent Teachers Organizations in Madison and Rumson, NJ; a member of the Zoning Board of Adjustments, Boro of Madison, Madison, NJ; and a member of St. Peter's Catholic Church in Queenstown, MD. She was aslo an active platform tennis player.

She is survived by her husband, Bart P. Donohue, III, of Queenstown, MD; son, Bart P. Donohue, IV, of Fair Haven, NJ; a daughter, Kathleen A. Donohue of Wakefield, RI; and two sisters, June Castin of Eatontown, NJ, and Maureen M. Miners of Woodstock, CT. A funeral mass will be held 11 a.m. on

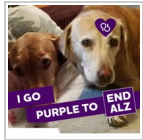
