



## Florence Lucille Garrett

November 28, 1922 - February 27, 2009

Lucille Garrett of Trappe, MD, died at the home of her daughter, on Friday, February 27, 2009. She was 86.

Born in the Hudson area of Dorchester County on November 28, 1922, she was the daughter of the late, Harry and Lottie Rhea Parrott. Harry was known to be the last fish peddler in Trappe. As a young child, she and her family moved to Trappe. Following her graduation from Trappe High School, Mrs. Garrett worked as an assistant cook at Trappe High School. She later worked as a nurse's aide at Memorial Hospital at Easton, then at Genesis Eldercare "The Pines" until her retirement. Mrs. Garrett was also a gifted seamstress and did alterations to women's clothes and was known to give home permanents.

Her husband of 57 years, David P. Garrett, died in May 1997.

Known for her generosity, Mrs. Garrett, loved cooking, baking, canning, and making all types of preserves. She also enjoyed working in her flower garden, watching birds, and doing all sorts of crafts, and was an avid John Wayne and Baltimore Orioles fan. A loving wife, mother and grandmother, she spoiled her grandchildren and children equally.

Mrs. Garrett is survived by three daughters, Joan E. Mowbray of Cambridge,

Linda P. Garrett of Parkville and N. Susan Shores and her husband, Tom, of Trappe; one son, John D. Garrett of Trappe; seven grandchildren; 15 great grandchildren; and one great-great grandchild on the way!
