Florence Jessee Malcolm, 75, died Friday, October 29, 2004 at her home in Chestertown, Maryland, surrounded by her loving family.

Mrs. Malcolm was a member of the Westfield High School Class of 1947 and was elected to the All State Chorus. She was awarded a scholarship to Bucknell University, where she majored in English and Art and was a member and officer of Delta Delta Delta Sorority and graduated with a Bachelor of Arts in 1951.

In Westfield, New Jersey, Florence was a founder, President, and Board Member of Miller-Cory Museum House, President of the Junior Women's Club, appointed to the Westfield Historical Preservation Commission, and a former member of the First Baptist Church. After moving to Chestertown, she sang in the Chester River Chorale, was a member of the Kent County Historical Society, the New Yarmouth Questers, the Presbyterian Church, and the Chester River Yacht and Country Club.

Mrs. Malcolm is survived by her husband of 53 years, Allen R. Malcolm and their four children, Marcie Malcolm of Westfield, New Jersey, Linda Louise Malcolm of Portland, Oregon, Valerie Malcolm MacFie and son-in-law, Richard MacFie of Howell, New Jersey, and Robert Malcolm and Karen Webb of Chestertown, Maryland. Also surviving is her sister, Dorothy Bachman and her

husband, Kenneth of Westfield, New Jersey, and three grandsons, James and Brian MacFie and Galen Malcolm.
