



Florine Ann Pawtowski

September 19, 1922 - May 8, 2023

Florine Ann Pawtowski was born on September 19, 1922, in St. Cloud, MN, to the late Nicholas J. Landsberger and Clara Juenemann Landsberger. She was their second eldest daughter, one of eleven siblings, and also an identical twin. She attended Cathedral High School in St. Cloud; graduating in 1940. She then continued her education at St. Cloud Business College in 1941.

Moving into her first job, Florine accepted an administrative position for two St. Cloud attorneys. When an opportunity arose to work for the Navy Department, Florine moved to Washington, DC. On January 16, 1943, she married Joseph Stanley Pawtowski, and they moved to Silver Spring, MD, in 1959.

Florine began working with her husband in their family business "Your Plumber." Sometime later, the company was renamed, "J.P. Seworootor, Inc." In 1989, after 46 years of marriage, Joseph Pawtowski passed away.

Florine resided in Silver Spring, MD, from 1959 until she moved to Centreville, MD, in 2005. Mrs. Pawtowski was a devoted member of Our Mother of Sorrows Catholic Church. She enjoyed watching TV and doing line dancing and aerobics.

Mrs. Pawtowski is survived by four children, Claudia Horney (Mike), Karen Hall (Thomas), Bonita Olds (Robert), and Martin Pawtowski. She was preceded in death by her son, Cloud B Pawtowski (Frances). She is survived

by her three siblings, Rachel Dusha, Ronald Landsberger, and Leroy Landsberger. Seven siblings preceded Florine in death, Grace Pick, her twin sister Eileen Quigley, Jerome Landsberger, Gerald Landsberger, Audrey Van Duser, Rev. Fr. Robert Landsberger, and Rev. Fr. Nicholas Landsberger. She is also survived by her fifteen grandchildren, forty great-grandchildren, and twelve great-great grandchildren.
