Floyd Emory Devers (90) passed away on March 8, 2017, in Easton, MD, after a period of declining health.

A native Washingtonian, Floyd was the loving and devoted only son of Theodore Emory and Nellie Owens Devers. Floyd attended Coolidge High School before enlisting in the Navy during the Second World War.

After his service, Floyd earned his apprenticeship as a mason working with his father before establishing his own successful business owning a full service gas station in Beltsville, Maryland.
