Forest Franklin Ellis of Massey, MD died Saturday, May 14, 2011 at the Chester River Hospital Center in Chestertown, MD. He was 84.

Forest F. Ellis was born April 5, 1927 in Chapmansville, WV, the son of the late William H. Ellis and Myrtle "Sims" Ellis. Mr. Ellis attended Chapmansville High School and was then drafted in the U.S. Army where he served in WWII; he also served in the U.S. Air force and served in the Philippean's. After his discharge he went to work for local saw mills as an equipment operator, most recently working for ATCO Pallet Co. He had a natural green thumb and could grow anything in his garden.

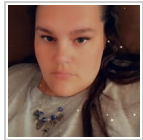

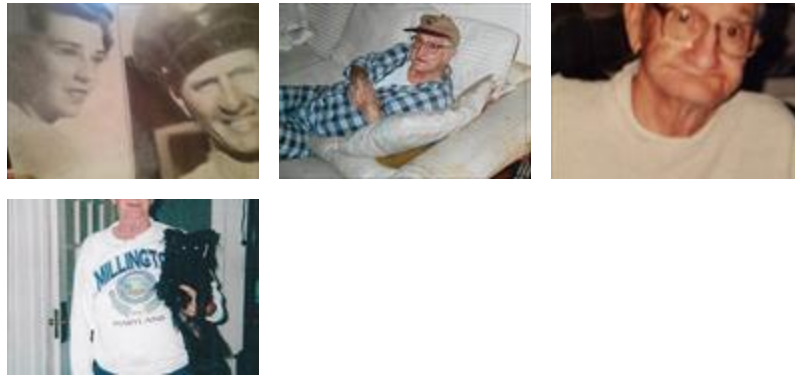
