



## Frances Jean Conrad

December 5, 1940 - May 29, 2015

Frances Jean Conrad of Grasonville, MD, died Friday, May 29, 2015, at her home. She was 74.

Born on December 5, 1940, in Wilmington, DE, she was the daughter of the late Maurice Joseph Hickey Sr., and Florence Knauer. A graduate of St. Elizabeth High School in Wilmington, she became a Lab Technician at Wilmington General Hospital.

After her marriage in 1961 to J. David Conrad, she focused on raising her four sons.
