



## Frances Mae Hadaway

July 19, 1931 - March 12, 2016

Frances Mae Hadaway of Millington, MD, died Saturday, March 12, 2016, at Shore Nursing and Rehabilitation Center in Chestertown, MD. She was 84.

Frances M. Hadaway was born July 19, 1931, the daughter of the late Charles Oscar Clough and Hester "Pearson" Clough. Mrs. Hadaway attended school in Sudlersville and Millington and, in 1954, she married Lawrence R. Hadaway. The two traveled worldwide due to Mr. Hadaway's career in the USAF.
